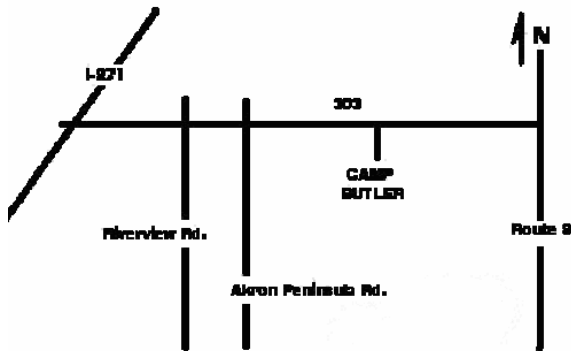


Directions to Camp Butler

Registration (Until 6/12/09)
\$60.00 per boy

Late registration* (6/13/09-6/27/09)
\$70.00 per boy

*Late registrations are not guaranteed a camp patch, t-shirt and water bottle upon arriving at camp.

Additional t-shirts can be ordered on the registration form. Additional patches will be available at the trading post.

Fee payment schedule:

- February 1, 2009 Registration begins
- June 13, 2009 Late fee begins
- June 27, 2009 Registration ends

Fees must be paid in full with registration.

Camperships are available through the council to help families send their boys to Day Camp. Applications for camperships are due at the Scout Center by April 30, 2009. For more information ask your Cubmaster or call 330-773-0415 Council office.

Information

Pack Leadership: Each pack provides its own chaperones through leaders, parents and other family members. An adult ratio of no more than five boys per one adult is required at Day Camp.

Health History: A completed health history form, signed by a parent or legal guardian is due with payment of fees. A health form is required for each scout and attending adult.

Health Services: A full time certified health officer is on duty at all times. Medication must be turned in to, and dispensed only by, the health officer. Please send medications in the original container with instructions, Scout's name and his Pack number.
