Dear Leader,

Please be sure that your Cub Scouts and parents know about the excitement that awaits them at the 2010 OP District Cub Scout Day Camp at Camp Butler. This year’s day camp theme is “100 Years of Scouting”! This information is for you to use with the parents to make sure that each Scout is ready to go to camp on June 28-30, 2010 (note that this is Mon.-Wed. and that Family Night is Tuesday!)

NOTE: Campership Applications are due to the Scout Center by April 9, 2010.

Again this year, each Pack is required to have a “Day Camp Coordinator.” The Day Camp Coordinator will be the information source for the Day Camp planning in the Pack.

Duties:

- ✓ Pass out the Day Camp information to the parents and Scouts interested in attending.
- ✓ Let Pack members know how to contact you.
- ✓ Collect all the registration, health form, camper release form and fees for each member of the Pack attending Day Camp.
- ✓ Coordinate and ensure that each day at camp, there are chaperones for the Scouts attending. The ratio is 1:5. (e.g., for 6 Scouts, you will need 2 chaperones, and every Tiger must have his own).
- ✓ Submit all the information collected along with a single check from the Pack (Payable to “Great Trail Council”) for all the fees collected before the regular deadline of Saturday, May 8, 2010.
